

Simple doesn't have to be uniform, and regular needn't be predictable. These box-shelves certainly come at you from an angle. Distinctive cutaways let you see and access the contents from the side, and their unusual lines means they work great as an ensemble. Rotate one 90 degrees, and the amount of light entering the box subtly changes. Treat your wall like a canvas by mixing and matching colours – the back plate is magnetic and easy to remove. Whether you're going for cosy, fresh or classic, restrained or exuberant, each colour casts its own aura, depending on the light striking the different colours of the powder coated steel back plates. On their own or in combination, they're a striking blend of the practical and aesthetic, a modular shelf system that we like to think of as 'skæv'\*. Straight? No. Straightforward, yes.


